

CITY HALL TO HONOR BELOIT, WI POLICE OFFICERS



Beloit police officers Jeff Loveland and Todd Dever will be honored with the Life Saving Award on April 28th at The Beloit Police and Fire Commission meeting. Officers Loveland and Dever are receiving the awards for heroic incidents in 2013; both officers successfully applied chest compressions to save the lives of two citizens while on duty.

On Nov. 2, 2013, Officer Jeff Loveland responded to a call regarding a non-breathing middle-aged woman suffering a heart attack. Using chest compressions, Officer Loveland restored her pulse in time for the ambulance to arrive and EMTs took over. The woman survived the incident and left the hospital after a few days.

On Dec. 10, 2013, Officer Todd Dever was dispatched to a residence after a man was found not breathing and without a pulse. When Dever arrived, he immediately began cycles of chest compressions. After four cycles, the man regained his pulse and ability to breathe.

The Beloit Police and Fire Commission meeting takes place at Beloit City Hall on April 28th at 5 PM.
